

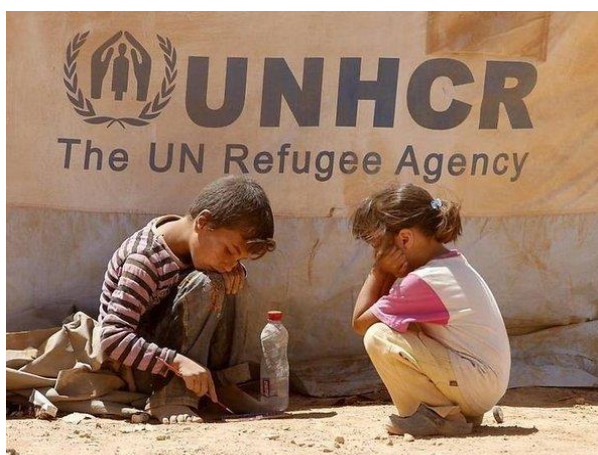
BADEN POWELL GUILD OF GT BRITAIN NATIONAL PROJECT Project “Fellowship Toy” for refugee children.

Launch Date 25th October 2013

We are pleased to announce that with NSGF-UK we are supporting the “TOYS FOR CHILDREN” in Zaatari Camp Jordan.

The sponsors for this project are: ISGF, UNHCR, Aviation Without Borders, Pitt Rivers Museum-Oxford. The UNHCR operation in Jordan has agreed to be recipient of our donations

Camp Zaatari is the 2nd Largest refugee camp in the world. With more than 180,000 refugees mostly from Syria and more than 60,000 children in this camp who are playing with plastic rubbish as toys.



HOW CAN OUR GUILD MEMBERS HELP

You can help by collecting good quality used toys, (listed below) for these children.

WHAT DO WE NEED TO DO.

Start collecting any of the listed toys and pack them into cardboard boxes. The dimensions of the cardboard boxes should be approx. **14inchx13inchx19inch**. The weight of the packed box should not exceed **50lbs or 23kgs**. The reason for these 2 package specifications are for their transportation by road and air to Jordan. When you have packed these boxes, seal them with good sound adhesive tape. Add the attached label to the boxes. Small removal type boxes like these can be purchased from Amazon for less than a £1 or £22 for 30 boxes.

HOW DO WE COLLATE AND DESPATCH.

You may need to appoint a co-ordinator or a small sub-committee to organise this event in your branch. You will preferably need to keep these packed boxes in one central location ready for despatch. When you have completed your project and ready for despatch, contact the National Secretary Allan Page on 01886 832940 or E Mail Allan.page@talk21.com who will arrange a suitable time for the boxes to be collected **And despatched to the holding depot. Please no more than 25 boxes per branch** Individual Town & Country members, no more than 5 boxes.

To help meet the cost of transportation of these boxes from the UK to Jordan, we ask For a small donation of £5 per box. This will help someway to meeting the full cost of transportation. Should you have any questions about the Project, please contact Allan Page anytime.

Whip and tops, picture books.
